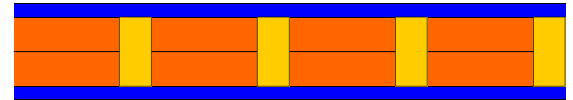

There are no paid employees and they survive on the donations of supporters. There are two medical missions per year that check on the health of the children.

Lion Brandon Archer introduced Dr. Carl Dethloff, Superintendent of the SAISD at our April 12 meeting. Dr. Dethloff talked about the upcoming school bond issue for \$148.9 million dollars. He talked about the projects that needed to be covered and that this is the second phase of the total required to take care of all the schools needs.
